### WWF AT WORK

As a Partner in Conservation, your annual gift supports WWF's diverse programs to protect nature and benefit people. Some examples of our work include:


Fighting wildlife crime. WWF has galvanized world leaders, celebrities and citizens in a major effort to end wildlife crime. Unprecedented resources, technology and collaboration are now going to stop the killing of elephants, rhinos, tigers and other wildlife for illegal trade.

#### Landmark protection for the Amazon.

Together with the Brazilian government, WWF launched an innovative financing mechanism to permanently protect 150 million acres of Amazonian rainforest—an area three times the size of all the US national parks combined.

Restoring America's prairie. WWF partners with Native American tribes and ranchers to restore bison and other native species and support communities in the Northern Great Plains, an iconic American landscape spanning more than 180 million acres of grasslands.

Transforming business practices. WWF leads visionary work with major corporations to create more sustainable business practices and reduce environmental impact, generating positive changes that touch producers and consumers around the globe.
